# Blaze Bio Ethanol Lantern

## **Operating Instructions**

STK #2518, #98535, #98536, #98537

### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

Before use, you must read these instructions and comply with the directions and rules for use and safety.

#### **FUELS AND SAFETY:**

USE NON-TOXIC LIQUID ETHANOL ONLY in these lanterns.

Do not use any other type of fuel. Do not add any other material or product to the fuel reservoir.

Follow any and all instructions provided by the bio ethanol fuel supplier. Pour fuel into the reservoir carefully avoiding spills. Do not light the lantern if fuel has spilled. Immediately clean up spilled fuel with mild soap and water ensuring all spilled fuel is removed from area before lighting.

Keep the lantern out of children's reach. Can be used indoors or outdoors in a sufficiently ventilated place measuring more than 10m with a standard ceiling height.

Move away all inflammable objects and / or products / materials; do not leave the lantern unsupervised during use or when hot or switched off with a full or partially full reservoir and only use the lantern for its purpose of ambience and decoration (do not use it to light a cigarette, grill foods or for heating and, generally, for any other use other than that for which it was manufactured).

Do not use the lantern intermittently and leave it to cool down regularly because the supports and sides, although designed for such use, can become hot due to temperatures emitted during combustion.

Always keep the supplied extinguisher nearby the lantern during use.

#### USE:

Place the lantern on a flat surface in a draft-free place, away from any heat sources and with the extinguisher close at hand.

It is imperative to only fill the reservoir when cold. Fill to a height of about 2/3 so that the wick is submerged, taking care to avoid splashing or overflowing.

Never add fuel to the reservoir when the lantern is working (lit) or cooling down (unlit).

Use a gas-lighter or extra-long match to light the fuel, and do not smoke nearby, especially when filling the reservoir or when the product is cooling down.

Do not touch any part of the lantern and do not move it or tilt it during use in order to avoid the risk of burns.

#### **END OF USE:**

Smother/put out the flame by covering the reservoir with the supplied extinguisher for a short time.

Do not touch any part of the contour lantern and do not move it or tilt it during use or when cooling down in order to avoid the risk of burns, while paying attention to any residual inflammable vapors. Store the lantern only after it has cooled down completely in an enclosed place out of children's reach.

Correctly following these instructions (which should be kept) will enable you to get full enjoyment from your new lantern.
